

# Christmas card bauble

## You will need

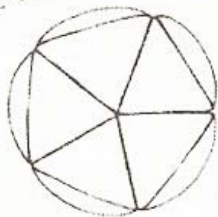
- Enough cards to make 20 9cm-wide circles
- Compass
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Glue or double-sided tape
- Paper clips
- Cotton or ribbon to hang

**1** Use a compass to draw 9cm circles on to the front of your cards and cut them out. Copy the pattern on the right on to the back of the circles, then score along the three lines you just drew. Fold upwards and crease along the lines (with the pattern facing upwards) to create three flaps.



**2** Spread a thin layer of glue or stick a piece of double-sided tape to the underside of

one flap, and stick it to another circle's flap (double-sided tape is less messy and you don't have to wait for it to dry). Make two domes of five circles. A small hole may appear where all five circles meet: thread a piece of cotton/ribbon through one of



these and secure it to the inside using a piece of sticky tape.

**3** Now stick together 10 circles in a line, as in the diagram. Attach tab A to tab B to make this line of circles into a ring. Stick one of the domes on to the top of the ring, and the other to the bottom.
