## CORNWALL SCRAPSTORE

Cornwall ScrapStore has been providing materials for art and play in the county for 17 years and has been a registered charity for 13 years. During all that time members have had free access to a wealth of fabric, paper, card etc. that would otherwise have gone to landfill and would have cost significantly more on the open market.

Due to a serious reduction in funding from Cornwall Council and doubts over any possible funding in further years the Trustees have had to make difficult decisions about the future of the organisation.

As a result:

- Cornwall ScrapStore employees have been made redundant but have agreed to continue on a part time voluntary basis
- Pool Store will only open Tuesdays 10 – 5
- St Austell Store will only open Thursdays 10 – 5
- Liskeard Store is now closed permanently
